# **Toilet Training** Tips:

We all know how difficult it is to toilet train any child, however,

toilet training a child with ASD may be even harder! Here are some tips that you may find helpful during this journey.

- Make sure that YOU are emotionally ready.
- Be sure that there are no other added stressors such as moving to a new house, a new baby, a sudden illness, etc.
- Record all data! This will help you see elimination patterns as to when your child eliminates most often and during what times of the day.
- If you see that your child's feet dangle, use a stool or a box to help elevate their feet so they can feel more stable while on the toilet.
- Have a bathroom basket ready. This is a basket full of toys, books, magazines, or other items the child enjoys in order to help alleviate some of the stress of this toileting process.




# Rios Golden Cut Autism Awareness Training
