2024 ABC FAST FACTS

Autism Education

- 375 new children enrolled
- 72% on Medicaid or other public insurance
- 81% under age 10
- 61% of parents were unemployed
- Provide 10 different classes including Understanding Autism, Toilet Training, and Safety
- Partner with SAPD and SAFD to provide training

Bereavement

- 509 new families enrolled
- 201 clients provided with grief counseling
- Average cost for one burial is over \$1,000
- Families are provided with 8 counseling sessions at no charge

Case Management

- 367 new children enrolled
- 15% of clients prefer Spanish language
- 78% of clients identify as Hispanic/Latino
- 60% of parents are unemployed

COMMUNITY CONDITIONS

- 46% of households in Bexar County couldn't afford the essentials such as housing, child care, food, transportation, health care and a basic smartphone plan (2021)
- 12% increase in Infant Mortality in Texas starting 2021

UTISM EDUCATION



In Bexar and the surrounding counties, over 40,000 individuals are living with autism. Our autism services are designed specifically for families raising a child or youth diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder, through services such as parent counseling, caregiver training, education groups, and first responder training. Both the New Braunfels and San Antonio Walks for Autism had record-breaking attendance in 2024. Nearly 600, and 10,000, respectively. The growth of the Walks highlight the need for continuing to expand our training curriculum, ongoing partnerships with the autism community, and providing an inclusive event for all who fall on the spectrum.



EREAVEMENT SUPPORT



No family should ever have to experience the loss of a child. However, when such loss occurs, ABC provides support to parents and caregivers through funeral assistance in the form of urns, caskets, and burial plots, bereavement support groups, and therapy for each surviving parent or caregiver. Each year, Any Baby Can hosts an annual Butterfly Release & Memorial, honoring those lost in the previous year. The Bereavement Services program is one of ABC's fastest growing programs, and the only program of its kind in our 17-county service area. In 2024, ABC was blessed with the Memorial Garden, a space for families to honor the lives of their children that were lost too soon, provided through support of the office of the Mayor, Ron Nirenberg and District 4 Councilwoman Dr. Adriana Rocha Garcia.



ASE MANAGEMENT

ABC Case Management is a one-of-a-kind program that helps families break down barriers to care and support. Our Case Managers work to assist and guide families through complex healthcare systems, to gain access to critical services. Every ABC family receives their own unique care plan, tailored to the needs of their child and family. On average, each of ABC's Case Managers have up to 40 open cases per month.

THE GARZA FAMILY

Children Assisted: Miles & Aiden Garza Program: Bereavement Services

"We felt a lot of love from Any Baby Can."

The Garza family lost their first son Miles, when he was 4 years old to Congenital Neutropenia/Wiskott Aldrich Syndrome. Miles' mother, Amber, reached out to Any Baby Can for counseling services and decided to donate her son's medical equipment to ABC to provide support for other families. Amber soon found out she was going to have another son, and in 2021 Aiden was born. The family was overjoyed. However, they soon found out that Aiden had a congenital blood disorder requiring a bone marrow transplant. On February 15th, 2024, Aiden passed away due to complications during the bone marrow transplant. The Garza family was heartbroken, but remembering the support she received from Any Baby Can for her first son, Amber reached out to the Bereavement Services team. Through the program, Any Baby Can provided burial for Aiden and counseling services for both Amber and her husband. More importantly, Any Baby Can provided hope and healing to their family when they needed it most.

Both Amber, Miles, and their daughter Isabella are active participants in the monthly support groups, and were there to help cut the ribbon on Any Baby Can's new Memorial Garden in May.









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THE CAZARES FAMILY

Child Assisted: Johnathan Diagnosis: Autism Spectrum Disorder

"Any Baby Can helped me find my voice."

Johnathan's family has been involved with Any Baby Can for over a decade. Through their participation in the Autism Services Program, and playing an active role in the annual Walk for Autism, Johnathan has grown from a nearly non-verbal, shy child into an outgoing, confident young man. Due to the support of his family, friends, and Any Baby Can, Johnathan proudly graduated from Brakenridge High School in 2020.

Earlier this year, Johnathan sang the National Anthem at the Walk for Autism in front of a crowd of nearly 10,000!
